-- You may review the lecture videos and use your notes, the lecture notes, the textbook, the ALEKS homework, and your calculator when working on this exam. You may NOT receive help from anyone else, give help to anyone else, discuss any aspect of the exam or any items related to the exam with anyone else, or use any resources not specified in the previous sentence.

-- You may submit your answers and scratch work either on a printed copy of this exam or on your own paper. If you use your own paper, you do NOT need to copy the question; just be sure you clearly label which question the scratch work and answer belong to.

-- If I can't tell with certainty which question any scratch work or answer belongs to, you will not receive credit for that work or answer. If you use your own paper, you DO need to copy the honor code and sign it.

-- To submit your scratch work and answers, you can either scan your work (if you have access to a scanner) or take pictures with your cell phone, then email me your scans or pictures.

--Be sure the writing in your scans or pictures is dark enough that I can easily read what you've written. If I can't read what you've written, I can't give you credit for it.

-- Make sure your final answers are clearly labeled.
